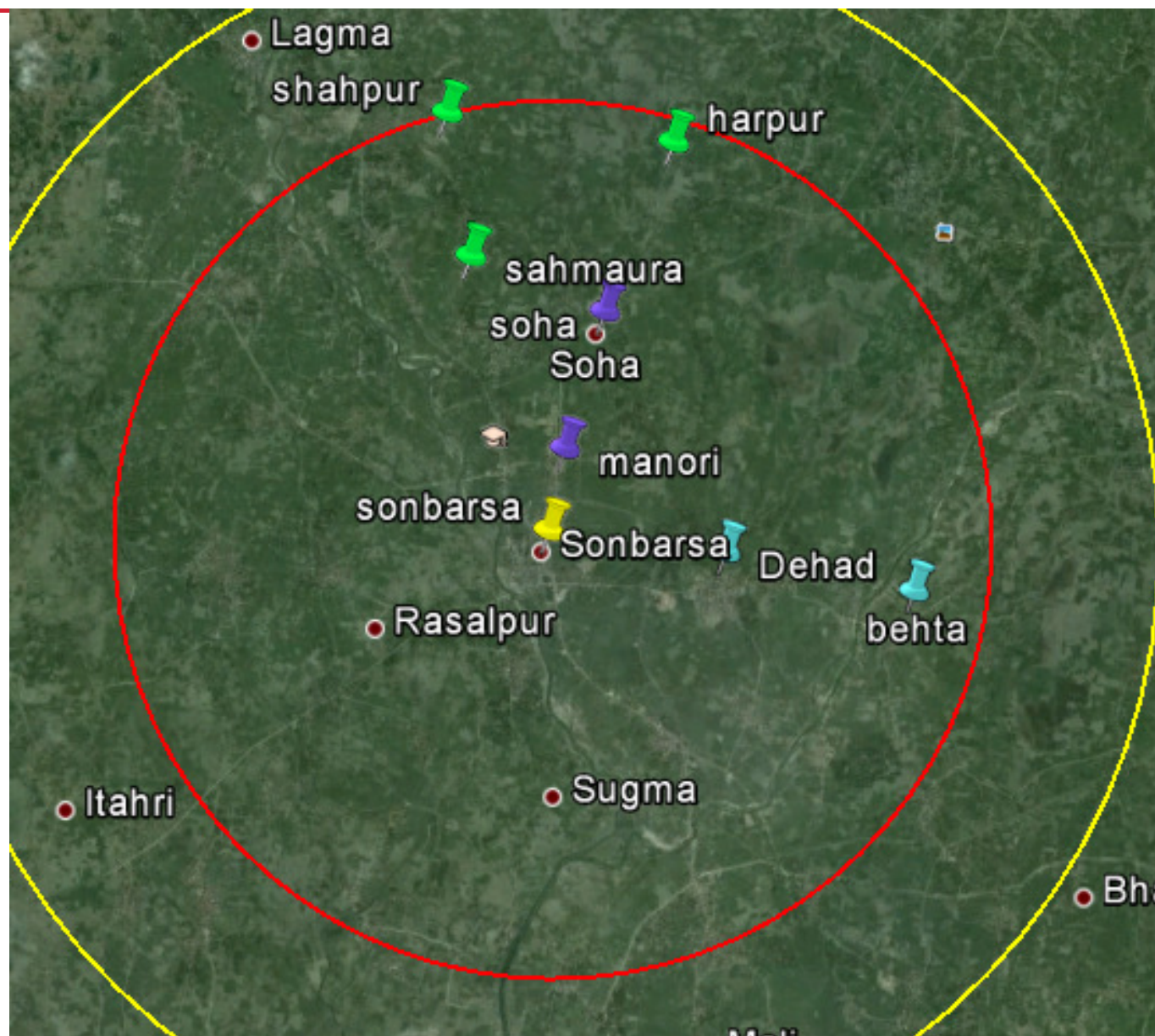

## ❑ *Basic Details*

- ❑ *It is a cluster of 30 densely populated villages*
- ❑ *The cluster is surrounded around NH130A*
- ❑ *NH 130 A which includes heritage bridge built during British era which connects Industrial hubs of Chhattisgarh and Madhya Pradesh*
- ❑ *Kunda Cluster is located in proximity to proposed “Sugar zone” of Chhattisgarh where second sugar factory is coming up*
- ❑ *This cluster is known for Sugarcane production and jaggary units*
- ❑ *Panchayats such as Khamariya, Ranpa, Pendri Kalan are to be declared as ODF soon.*



# Kunda Cluster: Pandariya

- ❑ *Basic Details*
- ❑ *Cluster is equipped with basic infrastructure such as road connectivity, well established Bus Stand, Banking network, PHC, ICDS Project Office etc.*
- ❑ *Kunda cluster is known for Haff river which supports vegetable production and horticulture activities.*
- ❑ *Infrastructure such as annicuts have already been built to conserve water and to put it for productive use.*
- ❑ *Kunda is equipped with Krishi Upaj (up)-Mandi which boosts agro-trading activities*
